# Twentieth-Century Ireland

From the War of Independence and the New Sinn Féin to De Valera, the IRA, and paramilitary terrorism, 20th Century Ireland saw a dramatic revolution of the Irish state and society.

This course studies the political, economic, social, and religious factors in the transformation of twentieth-century Ireland since the Rising of 1916.

Topics will include 20th century Irish nationalism, the Anglo-Irish Question, The Stormont Regime, and the modernizing of the Irish Republic.
