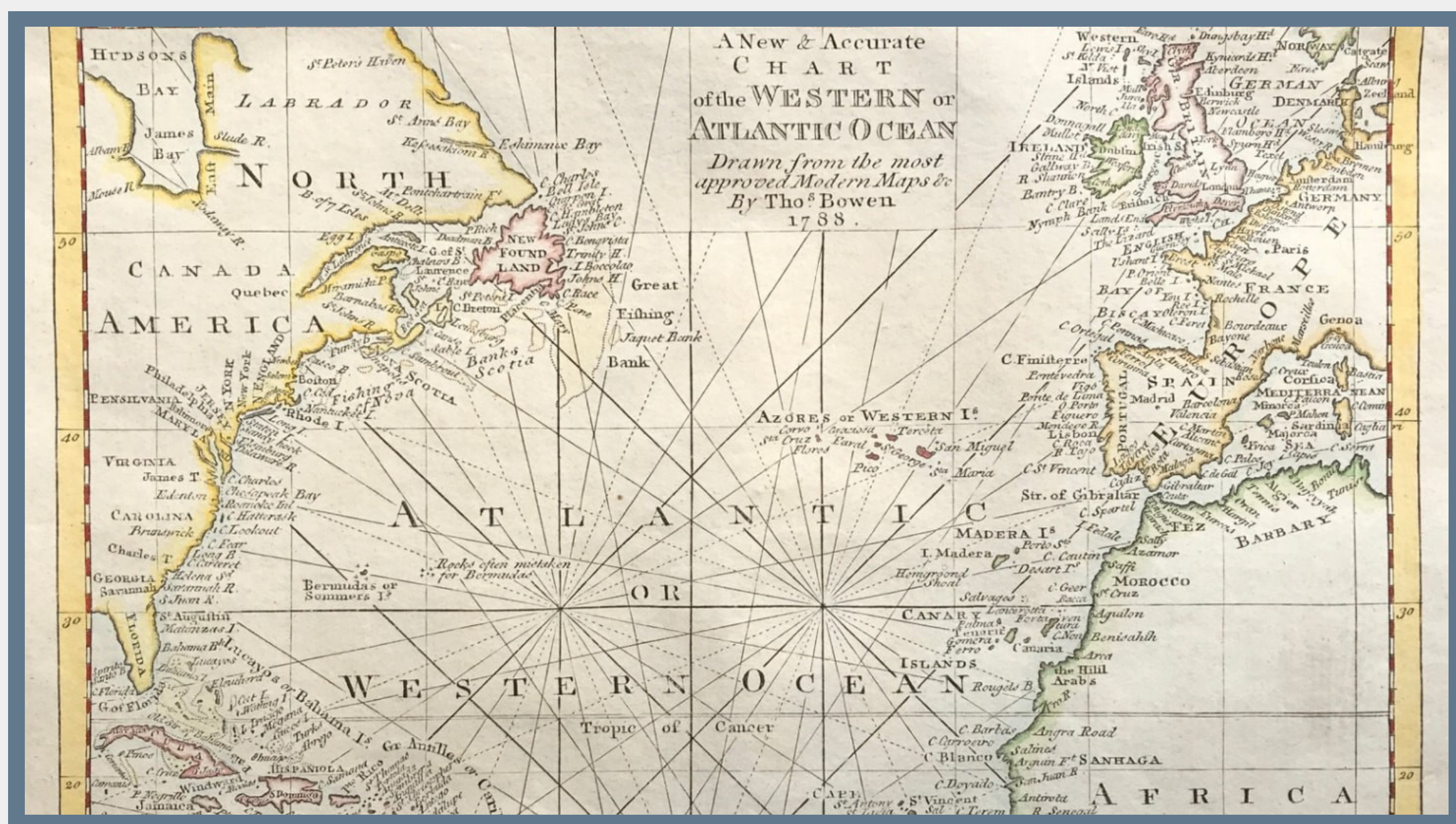

The dramatic rise of Atlantic history over the past few decades has demonstrated that places like Ghana, Scotland, Barbados, Rhode Island, Tenochtitlan, Bermuda, and indigenous/imperial borderlands were part of a larger, interconnected network of exchanges between Europeans, Africans, and indigenous Americans. Covering a period roughly from 1600-1800, this course will explore topics ranging from sugar to slavery, religion to revolution, chocolate to coffee, and politics to pirates!
